Education & Teachers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="#">Diffit</a>: article on a topic with sources, summary, vocabulary &amp; questions.</li><li>• <a href="#">MagicSchool.ai</a>: lessons plans, assessments, misconceptions, rubrics</li><li>• <a href="#">Magic To Do</a>: Auto creates lists of tasks, re-writes text for tone</li><li>• <a href="#">QuestionWell</a>: Generates questions and discussion prompts</li><li>• <a href="#">Yippity</a>: Generates flashcards and quiz questions from text</li></ul>
Generative AI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="#">Bard</a>: Sign up with a Google Account. Must be enabled by admin</li><li>• <a href="#">ChatGPT</a>: Sign up with a phone number and email address</li><li>• <a href="#">Claude</a>: Sign up with a Google Account, incorporates more data</li></ul>
Multimedia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="#">DALL-E</a>: images from textual descriptions using various artistic styles</li><li>• <a href="#">Dream Studio</a>: develop highly realistic images based on text prompts</li><li>• <a href="#">Slides.AI.io</a>: generates slides (headings, bullets, etc) from prompt</li><li>• <a href="#">Curipod</a>: students submit response to AI generated slides</li></ul>
Research & Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="#">Elicit</a>: surfaces academic papers based on research question.</li><li>• <a href="#">Perplexity</a>: Similar to ChatGPT but with sources cited.</li><li>• <a href="#">Quillbot</a>: assists with paraphrasing, synonyms, and re-wording</li><li>• <a href="#">Canva Magic Write</a>: Creates text based on prompt</li></ul>
AI Detectors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="#">AI Content Detector</a>: To gain more functions sign up for a free account.</li><li>• <a href="#">Crossplag</a>: Provides a score of likely plagiarism from 0-100.</li><li>• <a href="#">GPTZero</a>: Determines perplexity (complexity) &amp; burstiness (randomness)</li><li>• <a href="#">ZeroGPT</a>: Highlights text suspected to be AI-generated.</li></ul>
