Education & Teachers	 <u>Diffit</u>: article on a topic with sources, summary, vocabulary & questions. <u>MagicSchool.ai</u>: lessons plans, assessments, misconceptions, rubrics <u>Magic To Do</u>: Auto creates lists of tasks, re-writes text for tone <u>QuestionWell</u>: Generates questions and discussion prompts <u>EduAide</u>: Create lesson plans, resources, and assessments
Generative Al	 <u>Bard</u>: Sign up with a Google Account. Must be enabled by admin <u>ChatGPT</u>: Sign up with a phone number and email address <u>Claude</u>: Sign up with a Google Account, incorporates more data
Multimedia	 <u>DALL-E</u>: images from textual descriptions using various artistic styles <u>Dream Studio</u>: develop highly realistic images based on text prompts <u>Slides.Al.io</u>: generates slides (headings, bullets, etc) from prompt <u>Curipod</u>: students submit response to Al generated slides
Research & Writing	 <u>Elicit</u>: surfaces academic papers based on research question. <u>Perplexity</u>: Similar to ChatGPT but with sources cited. <u>Quillbot</u>: assists with paraphrasing, synonyms, and re-wording <u>Canva Magic Write</u>: Creates text based on prompt
Al Detectors	 Al Content Detector: To gain more functions sign up for a free account. Crossplag: Provides a score of likely plagiarism from 0-100. GPTZero: Determines perplexity (complexity) & burstiness (randomness) ZeroGPT: Highlights text suspected to be Al-generated.
